Novartis has changed the drying technique and the type of blister packaging for Kisqali. These changes mean it can be stored at room temperature.

Kisqali still contains the same ingredients with the same formulation. It will work the same way.

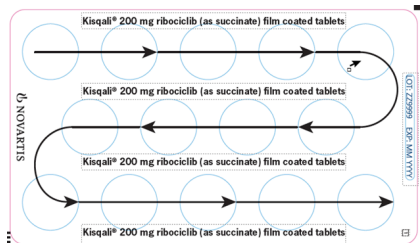
If you still have some old Kisqali, Novartis recommends you continue to store it in the fridge.
