# Your brand of medicine is changing

## Do you take one of these brands of medicine?

- Arrow-Venlafaxine XR
- Efexor XR

### Your new brand of medicine is called Enlafax XR.

#### Enlafax XR works the same as the other brands

Enlafax XR has the same active ingredient (venlafaxine) as the other brands. This means your new brand of medicine works exactly the same as your old brand. You shouldn't notice any difference in how it affects you.

#### Your new brand comes in capsules

#### Ask your pharmacist when your brand will change

You can ask to stay on your current brand, but it may not be available or affordable.

#### Your new brand has been carefully assessed

Enlafax XR has been fully assessed by Medsafe (part of the Ministry of Health). Medsafe ensures the safety of medicines in New Zealand.
